GUIDELINES TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- To get the best from the school for your child, you are advised to maintain a close contact with the school. We earnestly recommend that parents and guardians should look into their ward's school diary everyday and ensure that lessons and homework assigned for the day are done. Remarks given by Principal/Teachers in the diary should be seen and countersigned .
- Parents are not allowed to visit the class-rooms to see their children or teachers during regular teaching hours without the permission of the Principal.
- Parents are required to inform the school if there is any change in their address and telephone numbers in the standard performa available at school.
- Avoid asking for a half-day leave. In case of emergency, permission must be sought, in writing, from the Principal.
- Do not send your child to school, if sick or not good at health, to attend classes or even for weekly tests. Inform to school as well.
- Parents attention is drawn to the fact criticism of the school or teachers in presence of the child should be scrupulously avoided as it causes the students to lose respect for

their teachers with the consequent failure to learn from them that may retard their progress.

- If there is any legitimate complaint, please meet or write to the Principal at the earliest. Your complaint would be personally verified by the Principal and suitable action will be taken up.
- Any communication made by the parent/guardian should be addressed to the Principal through the class teacher. The name of the student, address and phone number, admission number and class/section should be clearly mentioned in the application.
- Parents should sign the progress report card and return it to the school within three days from the date of distribution. If the progress report is lost or mutilated, a replacement will be made after the payment of Rs. 100/- at the Administrative Office. Rs. 100/- will also be charged for replacement of the I-Card.
- The Name, Admission No., Class, Section and House of the pupil should be clearly marked on all belonging and uniform of the students.
- Parents are advised to ensure that their wards should attend school on the notified date at the beginning of the semester or after each vacation.
- Collection and distribution of lunch boxes and other belongings is not the responsibility of the school. Therefore, parents should ensure to send such things with the child only.
- Parents are advised not to send sweets, presents, etc to school for any occasion like Birthday, Teacher's day, Children's Day or any other festival.
- Parents are requested not to board the school buses, either to see off or receive their wards.
- Parents should not try to overtake and stop the school bus to facilitate the boarding of their wards as this can endanger the safety of the bus. Such attempts would lead to strict disciplinary action against the offenders.
- Parents should not argue with the teachers/conductors/ driver present in the bus. In case of any problem, a written complaint should be submitted to the Principal.
- Our school is a polybag-free zone. Parents are requested not to send or bring any articles like tiffin, stationery, craft articles etc. to school in polybags.
- Admissions shall be strictly based on availability of seats and meeting eligibility criteria and shall be confirmed only after furnishing all the requisite documents and fees/charges.
- The information provided at the time of admission in Registration Form and other supporting documents including Name, date of birth, etc shall hold true till the student leaves TERI PUBLIC SCHOOL. Any sort of discrepancy, false statements or misrepresentation of facts by the parents/guardians at the time of admission, when discovered, would result in dismissal of the student .
- Parents/Guardians are advised to keep TERI PUBLIC SCHOOL updated with any change of contact details in writing.
- Parents/ Guardians/ Visitors/ Relatives whose identification photographs have been provided on the student dossier, will only be permitted to meet the student.
- Disciplinary action would be taken against the student found doing insubordination and other acts such as bullying. physical and mental ill-treatment towards other students. A student found guilty of serious breach of discipline will be summarily expelled from the School without any liability on the part of the school.
- TERI PUBLIC SCHOOL takes care of the safety of the student. However, TERI PUBLIC SCHOOL does not accept any responsibility, legal or otherwise, for accidents or mishaps and TERI PUBLIC SCHOOL shall remain indemnified against any claim on such grounds.
- A clear calendar months notice in writing or a month fee in lieu of notice must be given before the pupil can be withdrawn.
- Those who leave school in the mid session will have to pay the fees as per the notice period .Transfer certificate will not be issued unless all dues are settled.
- The School Management reserves the right to change, amend, add or delete any of the above mentioned rules and regulations at any time without any prior notice. Students shall be bound by various rules and regulations framed from time to time by the Management for smooth running of the institute.
- Students are not to be allowed half day/ short leave only in emergency situations. Parents should take their children.
- Mobile phones and Bikes are not allowed on the school Campus..

- On the child's birthday, only toffees may be distributed in the classroom. Students of class VI and onwards are not permitted to come to school in any casuals on any day including birthdays and PTMs.
- In PTM students must wear a school uniform.

SCHOOL RULES

- Every student should bring his/her diary to school everyday and must put on his/her identity card.
- Parents are requested to avail school bus facilities for their wards to commute to school. Non-bus commuters should arrive at school 10 minutes before the beginning of the school time.
- A warning bell will be there 5 minutes before the start of the assembly which will be a signal for all to go to their respective classrooms. This should be done promptly and silently. As soon as the bell rings, the students must get ready for the assembly.
- Students should be habitually clean and always neatly dressed. Students should wear school uniforms on all working days and the school functions. Students who are not in proper uniform will not be allowed to enter their classrooms. No low waist skirt/trousers are allowed.
- No shouting or whistling is allowed in or around the school building.
- Running in corridors is strictly prohibited.
- Care must be taken of the school property and no student should scratch or damage any furniture item. Crafting on any sort of school property or on other belongings will not be tolerated. Damage done even by accident should be reported at once to the class teacher.
- Any damage done will be met by the concerned student, together with the fine imposed on him/her for such an offence. Any damage noticed must be reported to the class teacher immediately.
- Non-sikh boys get their hair cut at regular intervals. Sikh boys must wear turbans/dastar as per the school uniform.
- The following are strictly prohibited in the school premises:
*Mobile phones/1-pods *Calculator, walkman or any electronic gadget.
Note: Possession of any above article will result in direct expulsion from school without any notice and that article will be ceased.
 - No book, (other than text books or library books) magazine or paper should be brought to the school without the Principal's/Teachers' permission.
 - Lending or borrowing of money or other articles is not permitted.
 - Students are warned not to buy or accept anything from strangers.
 - Students will not be allowed to meet visitors during their classes.
 - The school reserves the right to expel a student with an unsatisfactory progress in studies or whose conduct is not good as per the school rules.
 - Students must attend festivals and functions celebrated in the school.
 - Students are not allowed to wear watches, ear rings or other jewellery.
Girls are allowed to wear only small studs. No student is allowed to put on nail polish/mehndi/tattoos.

- Students are not allowed to bring money or valuable articles to school.
- Bullying and using foul language are punishable offences.
- Students found tampering with the school records /property are liable to face strict disciplinary action.

BUS RULES

- The buses will not wait for latecomers.
- The student should stay away from the main road until the bus arrives.
- No student should come near the entry door of the bus until it has come to a complete halt. All students must occupy seats immediately after boarding the bus.
- The front door of the bus is the only authorised entrance and exit.
- The drivers are authorised to stop the buses at designated stops only, unless directed by the bus supervisor, for some authentic reason .
- When the bus is in motion, student must not move around in the bus and no part of their body should be outside the bus.
- Waste objects, trash/food must neither be discarded inside the nor thrown out on the road. It must be thrown in the dustbin only.
- Students will be held responsible for any damage to buses caused either out of negligence or vandalism.
- Unruly behaviour is strictly prohibited. Courteous behaviour is expected at all times.
- No refund/adjustment of the bus fare will be done, even if the bus is used for a few days only.
- The driver's attention must not be distracted for any reason.
- Students must travel only by the buses allotted to them by the Transport Officer.
- Students of Nursery to Class-II must be picked up at the bus stop by their parents/guardians, failing which they will be brought back to school.
- Strict discipline is expected to be maintained in the bus.

- Look upon fellow beings as brethren, irrespective of caste, colour and creed and maintain fraternity.
- Pupils should always greet and respect teachers, elders and friends in a pleasant tone whenever they meet them outside or inside the school premises.
- Always put on a proper, neat and clean school uniform.

ATTENDANCE RULES

Coming school regularly is an integral part of a student's life. This inculcates discipline and regularity in a student which in turn creates a value system that becomes an essential part of life.

- No student will be allowed to enter without a leave application if he/she remained absent the previous day.
- Students who remain sick for more than 5 days have to produce or submit a medical certificate from a qualified doctor at the time of rejoining the school.
- All students will attend school on the opening day after each of the vacation.
- It is compulsory for the students to maintain regular attendance during the academic year.
- A special certificate of Appreciation will be awarded to the students with 100% attendance.
- Minimum Attendance: It is compulsory for every child to maintain at least 75% attendance at the end of academic session.
- Absenteeism in weekly Tests;

Average marks will be given only to the student who is on leave on Medical grounds or on School Duty or due to any other reason granted by the Principal.

Classes VI to XII

It is mandatory for the students to appear for all weekly Tests/Periodic Tests as per schedule. In case the student is on leave on Medical ground, on School Duty or due to any other reason granted by the Principal, the student has to appear for the re-test as per the CBSE norms.

- Late Admissions Classes III-VIII

If the student is admitted late, he/she will be exempted from the tests held before his/her admission to the school.

Classes IX-X

If the students is admitted late, and has come from any board other than CBSE, he/she will be exempted from the tests held before his/her admission to the school and if the student is from CBSE, he/she has to submit the marks and grades record from his/her previous school as per CBSE norms.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- Scholarships will be awarded by the Managing committee of the school to the students who will secure 98% and above in class X and XII in CBSE BOARD EXAMS(In the form of cash amount).
- For class I-IX and XI scholarship will be awarded to school topper ranks First ,Second & Third .Percentage should be above 96%.
(Scholarship is in the form of a cash amount).

SCHOLASTIC AREA:

- Assessment of Pre-Nursery & Nursery, KG

There are no formal examinations for classes Pre- Nursery and Nursery. However evaluation of the child's progress is done on the basis of day to day performance. These theme based assessment are carried out in various ways which include written assessments via worksheets

via classroom discussions & interactions.

- The assessment structure and examination for classes I to VIII comprises of two terms i.e. Term-1 and 2 as explained below:-

Terms-1&2 (100 Marks) in each term

Periodic Assessment -20Marks

Half yearly -80Marks
